
CANADIAN BUSINESS ENGLISH - SUPPLEMENTAL

Take care to notice the small details, such as word choice and sentence structure, use of colour, and layout. Of course, be clear and make strong connections between your work experience, your educational history, and the job that you want to get. These examples have been written with a very general style that should work for most job hunters.
